





# Specialty Clinics

## Mission Bay Multidisciplinary Clinics:

### Birthmarks and Vascular Anomalies Clinic (BVAC)

Pediatric dermatology and derm surgery, plastic surgery, diagnostic and interventional radiology, otolaryngology, hematology, ortho.

Drs. Frieden, Mathes and Kittler. Twice a month.

### Pediatric Rheumatology/Dermatology Clinic (RDC)

Peds derm and rheum faculty and fellows.

Dr. Mathur and Dr. Cordoro attend. Monthly.

### cGVHD clinic

BMT, derm, rheum, GI, pulm, oral med, ophtho, PT/OT, etc.

Dr. Cordoro or Dr. Mathur at Mission Bay. Quarterly.



# Procedural Clinics

## Pediatric Surgery Clinic at MZ

Once or twice a month on Friday am or Wednesday pm at Mt. Zion with Drs. Cordoro and Mathes. Procedures that can be performed on an outpatient basis, like simple excisions and lasers. Fellow clinics also feature surgery.

## Ambulatory Surgery Clinic (ASC) at MB OR

Monthly. Fellows go with Dr. Cordoro and Mathes for laser and surgical cases such as excisions and nail matrix biopsies under general anesthesia.
